
## **Session 7: Member Economy Progress Report and Information Sharing**





- Impact of Covid-19 pandemic on value chain of agriculture products and food in Thailand
  - Change of consumer behavior food delivery service, online purchase, home cooking, and healthy live style
  - Closure of restaurant, hotel, small/medium enterprise, etc. labor migration from urban/touristic cities to rural/ agricultural industry
  - Logistics interruptions and disruptions unsold products (domestic and exportation)
- Shelf life and transportation
  - Cold chain transport by land for export of perishable produces
  - Cold storage: prolong shelf-life of produces and products for domestic marks
    → increase of number of packages
- More environmental friendly practices
  - Food delivery operators in Thailand → adding a feature in application
    → reduce plastic spoon/fork/knife
  - Food restaurant → biodegradable containers e.g. bagasse
- Food sharing: reduction of food insecurity and food waste
  - Food sharing pantries, Mobile truck, Food Bank
