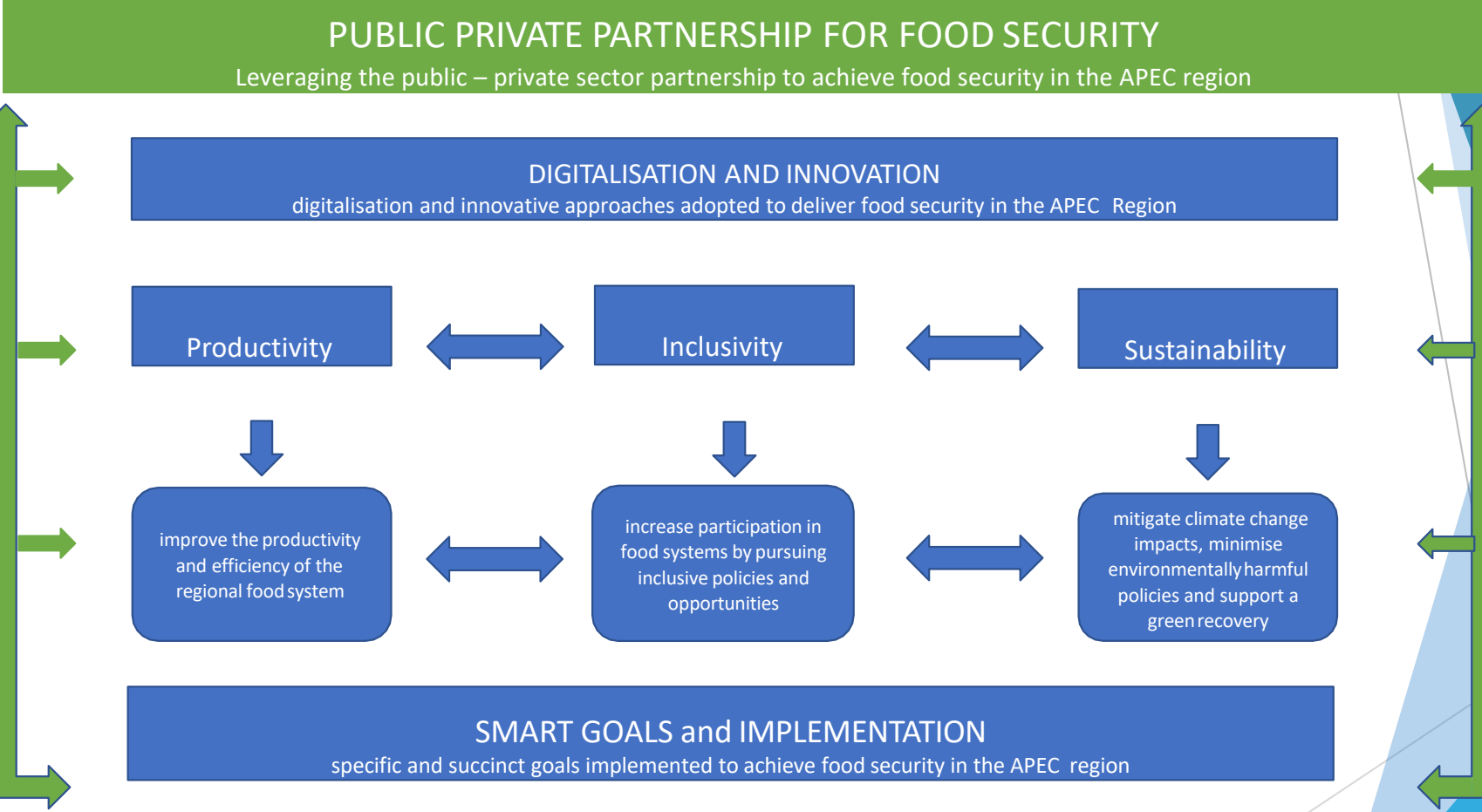

To date, over 30 businesses and organizations have joined the U.S. Food Loss and Waste 2030 Champions and publicly committed to reduce food loss and waste in their own operations in the U.S. by 50 percent by 2030.
